

MGA MINUTES 1/10/20

Meeting called to order by President Zowine at 1:30 pm

Minutes from December meeting were previously approved via email

TREASURER'S REPORT

Treasurer Snyder reported that our current balance is \$6564.49

MGA SHOOTOUT

Chair Smialek reported that we had 66 players, and after expenses and raffle income MGA received \$600.

GUEST DAY

Chair Fuzak reported that we had 87 players, and after expenses and raffle income, MGA received \$660. Discussion followed regarding the fact that the field was not full, unlike previous guest day events. It was moved, seconded, and approved that at the next guest day event, all MGA members receive an advance email blast regarding when the signup sheet will be posted, and the MGA will return to the prior practice of allowing a MGA member to bring up to 3 guests. MGA membership now stands at 187. It was further noted that only MGA equity members are eligible for Senior Cup, President's Cup, and Club Championship. All other MGA events are open to seasonal members as well as equity members.

MGA SURVEY

The board reviewed and commented on Day's first draft of a MGA membership survey regarding participation in MGA events. Survey final draft was tabled to next meeting.

TWO MAN BEST BALL SEASON LONG CHAMPIONSHIP

Three flights are filled for this event with first round play to begin Saturday, January 11. Payouts for this event will be \$50 per team for 1st round winners, \$100 per team for 2nd round winners and \$200 per team for the Champions of the event.

BUDGET

Smialek reported his analysis of income and expenses regarding working towards a possible budget. Discussion was tabled to next meeting.

MGA CUP

Smialek suggested the possibility of a yearend shootout for top 10 point getters from all MGA events combined, with points awarded based on prize money earned, as well as, possibly some points for participation. Matter was tabled to a future meeting, when next year's events will be discussed.

OPEN DISCUSSION

Taransky raised the possibility of the MGA sponsoring a Ryder Cup type of an event next year. Matter was tabled to a future meeting when next year's events are to be discussed.
