

MGA MINUTES 3/13/20

Minutes from February meeting were approved via email

TREASURER'S REPORT

Treasurer Snyder reported that our current balance is \$6064.11 with two remaining MGA events left on the schedule.

MARCH GUEST DAY

Report prepared by Day, presented by Snyder. We had 98 players and we paid 2 places gross, and 6 places net. Many favorable comments were received regarding the menu, especially the carving station. Modifications for next year's guest days, will include: 1) any team that has a 3 tee player will only be eligible for net prizes. 2) any player with a world handicap of 5 or less, will play the 4/5 combo tees.

MGA CUP

Grovum reported that the MGA Cup, (based loosely on the Fed Ex Cup of the PGA), would award points for each dollar earned by an MGA member in an MGA event. At the conclusion of the closing MGA ABCD event, the top 10 money winners would participate in a 9 hole shootout, with prize money to come from the MGA. Motion was made and seconded to move forward with this event next year. Grovum further reported that the MGA now has a website up and running, MissionValleyMGA.com, with a few items posted to date, with many more to come. Grovum will look into posting the MGA minutes on the site.

BUDGET

Smialek reported that he continues to make progress towards developing a budget for next year.

GOLF COMMITTEE

Zowine reported that the golf committee is considering a trial experiment with regular Titleist golf balls to be used on the range. We only have 40 of the original pushcarts in operating condition, as they are 30 years old, and the committee is exploring alternatives to this situation.

HANDICAP BEST BALL EVENT

Tisone reported that the last match is to be played 3/24.

MGA SURVEY

Zowine reported, on behalf of Day, moving that several recommendations from the survey be implemented immediately, with other suggestions to be taken into further consideration. The following suggestions are to be implemented immediately: 1) This summer the MGA will sponsor an ABCD event for all members, including summer non-members. 2) Increase the number of paid places for guest days, while taking a further look at increasing paid places at other events.

CLUB CHAMPIONSHIP

Championship is set for match play Wednesday, April 8, Friday April 10, and Saturday April 11.
